A SCOUT IS CLEAN!

Good hygiene makes for happy scouts and healthy scouts! Below are some key tips and bits of information regarding hygiene at the 2019 WSJ site!

- Each subcamp has several facilities -- including showers, washing stations, and toilets.
- Showers and toilets are individual stalls. Bathrooms are well lit and are non-slip.
- Showers for participants will be ambient temperature. IST will have solar heated showers.
- Facilities will be clearly marked and separated for adults/youth and male/female.
- Everyone should bring their own soap/shampoo (biodegradable is best)
- Some may wish to bring shower shoes. These are fine in the shower, but these types of shoes should not be worn elsewhere around camp!

Facilities are eco-friendly in so many ways!

- Ambient temperature showers save lots of water and lots of electricity
- Solar heating also saves lots of energy and keeps hard working IST happy
- Toilet water comes from recycled shower water. Toilet water is treated to safely return to outlying nature marshes.
- Design choices and water recycling allows us to save 7.5 million gallons each Jamboree
